Rules for Minibikes on Public Streets

A minibike is a small motorcycle or "pocket bike" and is classified as a moped in Michigan. To drive on public streets, no insurance is required however the driver must be at least 15 years old, have a MI driver's license or obtain a special moped license, and wear a helmet if younger than 19 years old. Mini-bikes are allowed on public streets only if they comply with the rules below. To be street-legal, it must have:

- At least one headlight mounted between 54 inches & 24 inches above the ground that can illuminate people & vehicles at least 100 feet ahead.
- At least a brake on the front wheel & a brake on the back wheel, both of which can be operated by hand or foot.
- A horn that can be heard from a distance of 200 feet.
- A rear lamp that emits a red light which can be seen from 500 feet behind.
- A rear stop lamp that emits a red or amber light when the brakes are applied & can be seen from 100 feet behind.
- A taillamp or a separate lamp that lights up the license plate & registration sticker to make it clearly legible from 50 feet to the rear.
- A muffler, rearview mirror and a firmly attached, permanent, regular seat.
- Handlebars no higher than 30 inches from the lowest point of the seat to the highest point of the handle grip of the operator.
- A manufacturer's identification number permanently affixed to the frame.

PERMITS REQUIRED for Maintenance Projects

State law requires permits for many home maintenance projects. Permits protect property values, can save you money (insurance may not cover work done without permits), can make selling easier (financial institutions may not finance a purchase without proof of a final inspection) and reduce potential hazards from unsafe construction. Did you know permits are required for these replacement projects?

- Driveway.
- Fence.
- Furnace.
- Hot water heater.
- Roof.
- Shower/tub enclosure.
- Siding.
- Skylights.
- Windows.

GOLF CART & ORV RULES IN ALGONAC

- Be at least 16 & licensed to operate a motor vehicle.
- Golf carts drive only during daylight. ORV's must have headlights and taillights.
- Obey traffic signals.
- Drive on correct side of street.
- Golf carts must drive less than 15 miles per hour; ORV's must drive less than 25 miles per hour.
- Do not ride on M-29, except to cross the street.
