Emterra is the waste and curb side recycling hauler. Trash can go out as early as 4 p.m. Wednesday and must be out by 7 a.m. Thursday.

ISLAND RESIDENTS ONLY:

Full-size trash haulers are too heavy to cross the bridges to pick up bulk items (*furniture, washers, dryers, stoves, etc.*).

Residents of Delta, Interlochen, Loch Haven, Venetian Way, Channelsyde, Cherry Lane, Chestnut, Elm, North - east of M29, Park, Roselawn & over Ruskin bridge must put any bulk items at M29 for pick up.

Sidewalk Snow Removal

Property owners are required to remove sidewalk ice and snow 24 hours after accumulation. After those 24 hours, if the city receives a complaint, the city will remove the snow and ice from the sidewalk at the expense of the property owner plus a penalty of 25 percent.

Parks

Algonac has several parks: Columbia, Lions Field, Scout Tot Lot, Riverfront, and Smith Field. The two main parks are: Riverfront Park, located on M-29 between Smith and Liberty Streets and has a half-mile boardwalk on the St. Clair River. The gazebo on the north end is available for rent.



Lions Field, located on Michigan Street near Dixie Blvd and includes a bike repair station, public pool, basketball courts, large play structures, horseshoe pits, a picnic pavilion, and a dog park.
