## FLOOD EMERGENCY DECLARATION

Water continues to rise to record levels. As a result the city of Algonac has declared a local flood emergency effective immediately per city ordinance 10-281. All owners of waterfront property must immediately provide adequate barriers to protect their property from the rising water, or the city may proceed to provide such barriers by or under the direction of the city, at a cost to the property owner. Please note there are over 550 Algonac waterfront property owners. If the whole community comes together, if neighbors work cooperatively, together we can successfully prepare for these exceptionally high-water conditions.

***Did you know that ... Algonac now allows Off Road Vehicles with headlights and tail lights??*** Drivers must be at least 16 with a valid driver's license, obey traffic rules & signals, drive less than 25 miles per hour, and never ride on M-29, except to cross the street.
